MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 P.M. There were 11 officers, directors and guests present. The December minutes were read and approved as submitted. The treasurer's report was approved as submitted.

We will also be checking with Menards, Home Depot, etc. The popcorn machine has been thoroughly cleaned thanks to Ed Stade. We will put the machine on the shelf in the concession area when we get the racks. Tom Connor reported that we had not received any bills from Chicago Street for the pizza. Discussion was held about notifying the pizza business in town to bid on providing pizza for the concession stands. This would need to be done in May so that everything was in place for football. We will continue this discussion.

Basketball: The feeder tournament was a big success. Making well over \$2000 for basketball.

Football: Requesting approval to purchase 70 complete uniforms. Will be meeting with Coach Stephens for finalizing purchasing. Approximate cost will be between \$9000-10,000. These will need to be ordered before the next meeting. Approved.

Dance: BHS Dance Team will be hosting their competition at EHS on Sunday, January 20th. They were advised that the concession person needs to talk to Diane with regards to concessions.

Hockey: Bill Baldwin brought in the schedules for the booster club. Silvia also talked about bringing BHS apparel to the hockey games.

Soccer: Dawn Daluge is working on getting the Krispy Kreme cards out.

OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS: It was brought up that the 2nd Tuesday of February there is no school. The members presented agreed to move the meeting to the 3rd Tuesday, February 19th. Silvia will e-mail all of the directors about the change.
