The meeting was called to order at 7:07 PM.

The minutes from the May 10, 2011 meeting were reviewed. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Lisa Wantroba and seconded by Heather Salatino. Motion passed unanimously.

**President's Report – George Kantzavelos** (Dan Lewis, Treasurer, was Acting President for the first portion of the meeting since George was delayed and Vice-President Bill James was not in attendance)

- Officer Elections were scheduled for this meeting. The new term is July 2011 – August 2012. No candidates submitted in opposition to the current officers; therefore, the current officers will remain for another term uncontested (an election is not necessary). Officers for the coming year will be: President - George Kantzavelos, Vice President – Bill James, Treasurer – Dan Lewis, and Secretary – open (no candidates submitted).
- Dan read a thank you note from Jalen Gardner, one of the scholarship recipients. Dan announced the 3 scholarship winners – Booster Scholarship: Jalen Gardner & Clarisa Czekajlo; Lenny Gulczynski Scholarship: Brianna Kulbeda.

**Vice President's Report – Bill James**

**Treasurer's Report – Dan Lewis**

- Dan provided the financial statements for all the Clubs in their folders. Fiscal year end is June 30 and Dan asked all the clubs to carefully review their statements.
- Dan is filing the required corporate reports and DuPage County Health reports.
- Accounts are balanced as of May 31.
- The Casino nights are not continuing. The money will be moved to the money market account.
- The Golf Team Golf Outing is scheduled for 6/24 and is looking for more golfers.
- Dan asked each club to send him their email membership list. Jeff mentioned that he provides information to the coaches, so the booster directors should go to their club coaches for listings.
- The total fundraising dollars are down about 2% from last year.

**Athletic Director's Report – Jeff Bral**

- Spring was a rough season as no teams made it past regionals.
- The Track teams had two 4<sup>th</sup> place finishes at state by seniors Alyssa Schneider (1600 meter) and Tynan Johnson (long jump).
- BHS will be participating in the Young Hearts for Life cardiac testing next April. This will include ~ \$3000 donation from Boosters. Hundreds of volunteers will be needed.
- Jeff is looking for several coaches for next year.
- In an effort to get Booster memberships up, with the \$25 fee members will receive admission to 8 events 2 each Girls & Boys basketball, 1 each to Girls & Boys volleyball, 1 football, 1 wrestling.
- Jeff and the assistant ADs are updating the Wall of Fame.

## **Club Reports**

### **Basketball – Lisa Wantroba**

- Tom Skelton is taking over management of the feeder program.
- Feeder tournament is scheduled for Sunday.
- Lisa is still not sure how much the Boosters owe the District for rentals. She is waiting for feedback from George who was working with resolving the issues.

### **Football – Brenda Partyka**

- Football had their first meeting of the season in May.
- The preseason Scrimmage is 8/19.
- Football will be doing more new stadium shirts with Wakoh Wear. They are starting with 100 t-shirts and will be giving them free with Booster memberships.

### **Cheerleading– Nancy Fachie**

- Cheerleading raised ~\$2500 at their first car wash on 5/21 at Joe Cotton Ford. They will be holding another Car Wash on August 13.
- Cheerleading will be doing the 50/50 raffle again this year.
- Cheerleading will be doing the Test Drive fundraiser with Joe Cotton Ford on September 17. Mr. Cotton offered this fundraiser to Cheer and Cross Country. Cross Country will determine if they will participate.

### **Dance – Kristie Bruneman**

- Dance held tryouts recently. They have 19 members on the team.
- Dance Boosters had their first meeting last night. They decided on several fundraisers for the coming year: Garage Sale (all items \$1) – July 16 & 7/17, Dance Workshop in August in partnership with Jr. Hawks Cheerleading; Dance Workshop in Fall, Bake Sale at Fine Arts Craft Fair, Business Sponsorships, and Sweetest Day Flower Sale.
- Kristie motioned to allow Dance to spend up to \$7200 for Dance Camp at Pheasant Run on 7/31-8/3 and \$5000 for camp clothes. Lisa Wantroba seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- Kristie motioned to allow Dance to spend up to \$2500 for new uniforms. Lisa Wantroba seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

### **Golf – Patti Hyzy**

- Golf Club is in desperate need of golfers for their outing on 6/24. George recommended that they reach out to several of the youth organizations (Raiders, Jr. Hawks, Little League, etc.) to each supply a foursome.

### **Boys Volleyball – Michael Gulczynski**

- Volleyball had Senior night and it went very well.
- Their first concession went pretty well – they made about \$1000.
- Michael thanked the Boosters again for continuing the Scholarship in his son Lenny's name.

## **New Business**

- Several new Club Directors were in attendance and asked for the rules of the meeting to be reviewed. The Booster Officers gave a brief summary of what items needed to be approved and how to obtain reimbursement etc.
- George noted that Brianna Kulbeda sent a thank you note to the General Boosters for the Scholarship she was awarded.
