The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM.

The minutes from the October 11, 2011 meeting were reviewed. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Cary Wick and seconded by Patti Hyzy. Motion passed unanimously.

**President's Report** – George Kantzavelos

- A meeting with the district's Superintendent and his direct reports to request their approval to take the Bartlett High School Activity Complex proposal to the U-46 Board of Education.
- Booster Officers want to make sure that everyone knows that the money for the Bartlett High School Activity Complex will have a separate bank account from the general Booster Club.
- The Bartlett High School Activity Complex is estimated to cost 7 to 8 million dollars to build everything. This is based on estimating everything on the high end. (Some of the features are Turf, lights, track, bleachers, concession stand, bathrooms, and locker rooms)
- George asked Jeff what is needed from Boosters to support the school. Jeff replied that Boosters has already budgeted to support the Heart Check America. He suggested a new ice machine since the one we have is on the fritz. Cary Wick will look into the cost of a new ice machine.

- George reminded us that the second wave of memberships for winter sports should be coming in. The Target meeting is Tuesday November 15, 2011 at 7pm. We may also want to have a table at home Basketball games to collect memberships.
- Dan commented this year's membership is up from last year at this time. Currently we have over 100 members. Keep the memberships coming in.

**Treasurers Report –Dan Lewis**

- Dan did a review of the Treasurers report. He pointed out that as clubs spend money for previous years they should fundraise to replace the funds.
- Dan commented that The Bartlett High School Activities Complex will have a separate account. Dan also talked to Harris Bank about a separate Escrow account so that if something is not approved we can refund the money to the donor. This is for over a certain dollar amount.
- Dan shared that the Chipotle fundraiser brought in \$641.98.
- General reminder is that all check requests over \$500 must be voted on.
- Please review the letter about donations that was passed out at the last meeting. Just to clarify that the letter is for the main Boosters to use.
- Dan wanted to remind the directors that all fundraiser must be approved by the Main Boosters. This will help in the coordination of timing and preventing of clubs doing the same fundraiser. Keep in mind this includes coaches fundraisers. If you have questions let Dan know.
- We got our first donation from ABIT for the gas/electric fundraiser.
- George received a bill from Pasta Mia from back on April 16, 2011 for \$305 in pizza. We are asking which club does this belong to?
