- We hosted the 2<sup>nd</sup> round football playoff game.
- Tennis won the sectional meet.
- Winter sports will be starting in approximately 2 weeks.
- A national early signing day was held on 11/10, for girls basketball player, Lindsey Schrader. She will be attending Notre Dame.
- There were approximately 700 athletes that lettered in fall sports.
- We hosted the soccer sectional.

**Club Reports**

**Fine Arts – Pip Tegtmeyer**

- Pip thanked all the volunteers that assisted with the setup for the craft show. Also, there were excess pop & chips that were purchased and asked if basketball or wrestling could use these. Joe will look into this.
- The Fall play is coming up, there will be an Orchestra concert on 11/18, and a Razzmatazz concert on 11/10
- They are working on the sound & video for the auditorium. This should be completed during the December timeframe.
- The spring play, Miracle Worker, will be held 2/10 – 2/12/05.
- The musical will be held 4/14 – 4/17/05.
- Pip made a motion that fine arts would like to have a cell phone recycling fund raiser. There would be collection buckets for the phones placed around the school. The date to do this has not been determined. The motion was seconded by Chris Lopatkiewicz and unanimously approved.

- The Blue & Gold meet will be held on 11/20. There will be 8 varsity home meetings and a Bartlett Freshman tournament.

**Baseball – Mike Wenc**

- Mike stated that baseball would like to sell BHS Hawks spirit wrist bands. He made a motion that baseball be allowed to spend \$1,300 on the purchase of the wristbands. The selling price has not been established as of yet. The motion was seconded by Joe Paladino and unanimously approved.

**Old Business**

- Joe stated that the signs have come in for the gym and will be hung up.
- Dan stated that a meeting was held with the head of grounds to discuss the baseball & softball field issues. The fields have been worked and these have been aerated and the work was done on the warning tracks. On the freshman girls softball field, a temporary field is being explored. For the varsity girls softball field, there is a major issue with drainage. The field will be built up a few inches to address this issue. On the boys varsity baseball field, it was built up a few inches. These will be worked on annually. The track is going to be worked on. A question was asked about lighting issues. Dan discussed that this would need to be addressed at the district level.
- Tami reviewed the proposal from the 3 vendors for Hawk wear. It was determined that Inspired Attired would be the vendor of choice. Tami made a motion to purchase an initial order of sweatshirts & hooded sweatshirts. These will be sold at \$30 & \$40 respectively. The order will not exceed \$3,500. The motion was seconded by Dan Palmer and unanimously approved.
- Chris asked a question on how to get the web site charge get billed automatically. Len & Bob will work with Chris on this.

**New Business**

- Joe stated assistance is needed to install the Wall of Fame. This will be done in the next month with Mark Leffler. A total of 80 frames will be installed

Tami Mercadante motioned to adjourn the meeting. The motioned was seconded by Joe Paladino and was approved unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 8:02 PM.
