

Dick Stephens - Football Booster Club Scholarship (1) \$500 non-renewable scholarship

The \$500 scholarship was created to honor Dick Stephens, one of the founding fathers of Bartlett High School football, having served as its inaugural head coach from 1998 – 2003. He went 27-22 as the Hawks' first coach and made three playoff appearances before retiring from U-46 and returning to his home state of Michigan. He returned to Bartlett High School as a volunteer coach from 2008-2015.

Dick Stephens is also the all-time winning coach at Elgin High School during two stints from 1969-1977 and 1987-1995. Stephens also coached for 23 seasons at four schools in Michigan, and has a lifetime coaching record of 211-203-4.

To qualify for this scholarship, the applicant must meet the following requirements:

1. Applicant must complete the BHS Local Scholarship Application form
2. Applicant is a Bartlett High School senior graduating in 2022.
3. Applicant was a member of the 2021 Bartlett High School football team.
4. Applicant must write a one page essay (with double spaced lines) describing How football has impacted his life in High School.
5. Applicant must be attending a 2 or 4 year college or university, technical school, vocational school or trade school following high school graduation.
