Athletic Director's or Principal's Report – Jeff Bral

- Group Interpretation won Sectionals, going to State on Thursday; Oak Park is hosting;
- Basketball:
 - Girl's Basketball had great games, lots of improvement
 - Boy's Basketball hosted Sectionals
 - Sold out the gym in 32 minutes

- Tuesday was Glenbard West High School, had ESPN there
 - 5 guys on GWHS team will play D1
 - Created a Press Room for Fridays game- lots of compliments
- Used Beacon Academy from SEHS to broadcast the games
 - YouTube channel increased from 600 to 1300 viewers
 - Hudl wasn't working
 - Went live streaming on Facebook during games
- Many asked why Tony Sanders wasn't there
- Had lots of BHS students and Community attend
 - Issue with students using Larkin Sectional tickets to get in
 - Bral recommended to ISHA to color code each Sectional
- Adena commented that Concessions went really well, raised over \$2,000 for all of the games. Needed to raise prices to offset increased cost of items
- Kurtis Park the IHSA superfan came and spent time with Bral
- Track- Indoor is done; transition to outdoors now
- Registration for Spring is done
 - Working on Summer Camps now
 - Watch for information after Spring Break
 - It will be free again this year
 - District will pay schools \$1 per child attending per hour
 - Will be appropriately dispersed to the sport/activity accounts for spending
 - District will pay Coaches this year
 - Last year A.Ds were told one thing and given flat sum of money for Summer programs; not enough to compensate fairly
