<u>Treasurer's Report –Adena Hedeen</u>

Currently, our accounts are as follows:

Activity Complex: \$97,832.33 (money market)

Main Checking (Clubs): \$150,982.48

- Indoor Concessions food permit has been completed. Cost \$591
- Outdoor food permits must be applied for by each Club's event
- UNCLAIMED DEPOSITS: Over \$2600 unclaimed now. Clubs review your deposits and your statements- make sure they reconcile! Email Adena if your statement is missing deposits ○ Sept. 2021- \$664 deposit unclaimed
 - o Oct 2021- \$1331.00 deposit unclaimed
- Remember to email the Treasurer when you submit a deposit
- Boys Lacrosse (U46 Co-op program Club) has brought forth a request to transfer funds to the SEHS part of the team
 - Bral- SEHS Boosters is not run the same as ours. Financial fighting occurs, no checks and balances like BHS Boosters have established
 - Funds are not the Boosters, they go to the Teams
 - Gac- Have SEHS part of the Boys Lacrosse bring their bills to BHS Boosters and we will review and pay from the account; We have a more flexible system

Athletic Director's or Principal's Report – Jeff Bral

- Congrats to Fine Arts for Legally Blonde show
 - Everyone that attended said it was great
- Group Interpretation won 8th in State, congrats!
- Discussion of Police Escort for events
 - o It has typically been teams, not small groups or individuals
 - A small group of students lobbied BPD to get an escort on their own
 - Tony Sanders believes all should get an escort not matter how many
 - Not realistic, it is expensive and disruptive to the school day / staff's day with the band send-off, breakfast, etc.
 - We need to be fair to all
 - Going to do Staff Escort for all, with t-shirts for IHSA & State Qualify for all
 - Police escort to Army Trail & 59 for groups of 7 or more only now
 - o SEHS does elaborate celebrations for everything, not realistic
- Gac- what about the small white buses U46 owns for travel?
 - We hear there is a bus driver shortage, post trips and when drivers pass, offer to school staff to drive the trip
 - o Bral- (4) BHS Staff offered to drive for teams, it's an ETA issue- how to pay them;
 - Issues are beyond that- drug testing, physical, Business Services won't park them on school property (fear of vandalism)
 - o Bral- enough buses for each high school to get one
- Track/Field- EHS co-hosted the Flying Hawk Invitational at EHS, good relationship with A.D. Pennington at EHS. Great new facility at EHS
 - o Boys had a good meet. Winner? Bral will look it up and send it out
 - Every BHS win was a new record for BHS
 - o Girls was canceled due to forecast, weather turned out to be great
- Busy end of year
 - SATs just took place
 - IHSA asked BHS to host other Regionals (softball), Bral said no. Too much this year
 - Prom is on 5/21, rented the whole facility this year. Luckily sold enough tickets to cover the cost plus some
- It's been a horrible Spring season for weather- behind on games; getting caught up now on Varsity games, only 1 behind for baseball and softball
- Still issues with games
 - Dealing with bus driver shortages to get to games
 - Umpire shortage too
 - Moving games/events to make it work
 - o We are fairing better than other Districts like Glenbard and West Chicago
- Adena- What did you make on hosting Basketball Sectionals?
 - o Bral-\$2400 for Girls, \$10,000 for Boys; less all of our hosting expenses
 - Bral- Looking to redo the padding in the gym on the walls with some of the money
 - Other purchases made from A.D. budgets this year, include, but not limited to:
 - 100 track hurdles @ \$15,500
 - o (3) carts for mats (cheer, etc.) @\$8,750
 - o Girls batting cages behind the softball dugout
 - These will be summer projects for installation

- The District now has an Age & Obsolescence (A&O) Athletic plan
- Summer Camps are free unless there is a fee to participate in a Tournament, etc.
 - Register for all of them on 8to18
 - Age of camp varies by program
 - Wrestling program has families spreading the word and pushing for it; need all programs to have that done.
 - Adena will tag Bral on 8to18
 - Martha asked about the Wall of Fame in school- it looks old/outdated info.
 - o Bral- looking for parents to take on the time to update/maintain it
 - Ken Pavell got the Wall started
- Sandy Frontzak, Bral's secretary is retiring in 2 years
